Classes run from September through May. Our recital is normally at the end of May. Recital is optional although 99% of students choose to participate.

<u>Pre-school dance classes</u> – This dance class are designed for beginner dancers ages 2-4. Most students begin with preschool. The classes are a combination of Tap and Ballet. The children learn a <u>Tap</u> routine for their recital number. <u>All other level classes</u> – If you are not sure which level class to register for please speak with your current teacher. The schedule provides a basic age guide for new students who have not taken dance from us before.

<u>Tuition payment</u>: FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE YOU MAY NOW PAY ON-LINE USING YOUR CREDIT CARD, DEBIT CARD OR EVEN A PAYPAL ACCOUNT. GO TO <u>WWW.THEBALLERINA.COM</u> AND CLICK ON PAYMENTS. The fee for dance lessons is a <u>yearly fee</u>. You may break the payments down into monthly installments. September and October are due before classes begin in September. If you choose to pay for the entire year via cash or check in September you will receive a 5% discount. Payments made after the 30th of each month are subject to a \$10.00 late fee. <u>Please do not misconstrue the payment schedule as being a monthly fee but a yearly fee divided into equal payments</u> that is an obligation of the parent whether or not your child attends all the lessons. If you choose to remove your child from the school, you will only be obligated to pay for the last month your child attended classes. Your child may make up any lesson missed in another class of that level; just ask the desk for a current schedule of classes.

<u>Costumes</u>: A costume deposit of \$50.00 per costume is due in November and the balance of the costume is due in February. This deposit indicates that your child would like to perform in the recital and that you will be responsible for the balance of each costume ordered. Costume prices are anywhere from \$85-\$150. No costume will be distributed unless paid in full.
